Saturday, bright and early, we'll head the cattle towards town, picking up one day riders along the way, and visit the Hernando Heritage Day Festival (around 2:30pm) before ending the drive. Once participants' and cattle are settled in at the festival grounds they will have the treat of local talent and Nashville recording artist, Ryan Weaver, headlining the Southern Heritage Festival concert starting at 3:00PM. The undersigned participant fully assumes all risks associated with the participation in an equine activity and holds the sponsor(s) of the equine activity, owner(s) harmless from any injury, death or damages incurred as a result of equine activity or participation of the equine activity, including but not limited to injury or death due to: faulty equipment or tack; any failure on the part of the sponsor to determine the ability of the participant to safely manage the particular equine based on the participants representation of his or her ability; a dangerous latent condition which was known to the equine activity sponsor, equine professional, or person and failed to post warning signs; a sponsor committing an act or omission that a reasonably prudent person would not have done or omitted under the same or similar circumstances or that constitutes willful or wanton disregard for the safety of the participant, which act or omission was a proximate cause of the injury of intentional injury of the participant.
